### STEP 1: DITCH THE GENERIC FORMAT

#### Avoid these:

- Microsoft Word default templates
- Functional resumes with no work timeline
- Generic summaries like "hard-working team player"

#### Use instead:

- Chronological + Hybrid layout
  - Visible job titles, dates, metrics
  - A trust-led headline like "Remote Customer Support Pro | Scam-Safe Hiring Aligned"

### STEP 2: MATCH THE JOB BOARD

Different boards = different filters.

#### FlexJobs-Ready Tips

- Use remote-first language in top 3 bullet points
- Avoid buzzwords and overly casual tone

#### The Ladders-Ready Tips

- Lead with achievements (e.g. "Increased retention by 24%")
- Add an "Awards + Metrics" sidebar
- CTA: [The Ladders](#)

#### IAP Careers-Ready Tips

- Align to async-friendly keywords (e.g. "timezone-flexible", "self-managed")
  - CTA: [IAP Careers Resume Tool](#)

### **STEP 3: SHOW REMOTE TRUST SIGNALS**

#### **Add a "Remote-Ready Toolkit" Section:**

- Tools: Slack, Notion, Zoom, Asana, GSuite
  - Traits: async communicator, self-disciplined, timezone-adaptable
  - Optional: VPN use + scam filtering knowledge

### **STEP 4: PDF + TRACK IT**

- Save as: `FirstnameLastname_RemoteResume2025.pdf`
  - Always send PDF, never .docx or .pages
  - Log applications + feedback in tracker sheet
